## Introduction

The Ironmasters Section welcomes you to the Last of the Summer Run event. The event will run for four days located at the Engine and Tender camp site among the rolling hills of South Shropshire

A camping field has been set aside for the event next to the pub and can accommodate a large number of caravans/campers and tents. The site is slightly sloping in places but not excessively.

Participants will be able to camp overnight at the Engine and Tender or visit on any of the days. There are also many camp sites in the surrounding area that can be booked independently, you may wish to extend your stay, at the Engine and Tender, and enjoy all that Shropshire has to offer the visitor, especially the historic town of Ludlow and our industrial birthplace, The Ironbridge Gorge with all of its museums and fascinating history.

The fees for camping are:-

Tent	£5 per night
Caravan/Camper	£10 per night
Electric Hookup	£2 per night

There are water points, toilets and shower block on site. The pub also serves hot meals at reasonable prices. Breakfast can pre-booked the night before for those who may be camping, or those who can't cook, won't cook....., you know who you are.

For the Friday and Monday green lane runs we will operate an 'end over end' with leader and tail-end Charlie. It must be stressed riding on green lanes can be difficult and tiring, there will be no breakdown backup, so please ensure you and your bike will be capable of completing the course. There will be a lunch stop as on the Social runs where food will be available, we will be stopping at the TBA pub.

### Petrol

Petrol should be available on all of the routes comprising this event, however there is petrol at Craven Arms which is located 2 miles from the camp site with long opening hours. Riders are advised to ensure they have enough petrol to complete the course.

## Regulations

### Eligibility

The event is open to any motorcycle, sidecar outfit or three wheeler manufactured before 1<sup>st</sup> January 1986 for the Saturday and Sunday runs. Additional motorcycles of later manufacture may be entered for Friday and Monday green lane days at the discretion of the organisers.

### Legal Requirements

Drivers and their machines must comply with all legal requirements including the display of a current Road Fund licence or exemption disc. Drivers must ensure that they have a minimum of Third Party insurance cover for this type of event. You may be required to produce proof that you comply with legal requirements at any time during the event. Day membership will be available for non-members at £3 per head as advised by Allen House.

### Entry Fees

As in previous years there will not be an entry fee for this event.

### The Courses

For the Saturday and Sunday social runs there will be route sheets allowing participants to ride at their own pace. Both days will feature a mid-morning coffee break etc, and a lunch stop where meals, bar snacks and sandwiches will be available.

The lunch stop will be at a local hostelry.

## **Provisional Schedule for the Weekend**

**Current VMCC membership cards must be shown when signing on.**

All runs will start and finish from the camping field at the Engine and Tender.

Friday 13<sup>th</sup> Aug – The Green Lane Run – These will be a leisurely run on fairly level green lanes and should be manageable for all riders. The route will be ‘end over end’ and will take in lunch at a local hostelry.

Although post 1985 trail bikes are welcome, we would advise lower capacity machines, no enduro machines and all machines must be reasonably silenced. Signing on will open at 09:00 and the run will start at 10:30am

Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> Aug – This will be a social run on mainly quiet lanes taking in the stunning South Shropshire countryside. This will be a route card run allowing riders to set their own pace and will be approx 45 miles for both the morning and afternoon runs. We will meet up for lunch at a local hostelry. Signing on will open at 09:00 and the run will start from 10:30am

Saturday Evening – A social get together over an evening meal in the Engine and Tender will be arranged. So we can reserve enough seats please indicate on the entry form if you wish to book places, this will help the catering staff if there is a large response. For your entertainment there will be a quiz consisting of general knowledge and general ignorance.

Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> Aug - This will be a social run on mainly quiet lanes taking in the stunning South Shropshire countryside. This will be a route card run allowing riders to set their own pace and will be approx 45 miles for the morning and 25 miles for the afternoon run. We will meet up for lunch at a hostelry. Signing on will open at 09:00 and the run will start from 10:30am

Monday 16<sup>th</sup> Aug – The Mirror Green Lane Run – This will be the same route as the Fridays run but in reverse, so the hills you went down on Friday will have to be climbed up today. The routes will be ‘end over end’ and will take in at a local hostelry.

Although post 1985 trail bikes are welcome, we would advise lower capacity machines, no enduro machines and all machines must be reasonably silenced. Signing on will open at 09:00 and the run will start at 10:30am
